

Responsibility of School Personnel

It is expected that the instructional staff will become sufficiently informed to explain the district's program, its problems and needs to the public.

Positive relations with the community are made possible through the efforts of all district personnel. All employees are expected to use good judgment, tact and tolerance in dealing with each other, with students, parents/guardians and the general public. It is assumed that all staff members will exhibit high standards of conduct at all times.

The assumption is made that the staff will exhibit high personal and professional standards of conduct at all times. One aspect of such conduct is the willingness to offer and receive constructive criticism through established professional channels.
