

Public Performances by Students

Participation in radio and television programs by the schools will be governed by the following regulations:

1. Assignment editors, reporters and members of the media should contact the district Information Officer, Superintendent or principals rather than students or social or school clubs. Principals will notify the Superintendent through the district Information Office.
2. The program should be of educational value to participants and to the audience, or of an entertainment type which is representative of school activities and in the bounds of what the schools consider good taste. The general program and the sponsor and product must meet the district's standards of ethics and good taste.
3. Schools should avoid participation in programs that occur during the opening week of a semester, examination periods, graduation week or at any time when school routine will be seriously disrupted or students' academic progress will be imperiled.
4. Students appearing as individuals or as representatives of groups other than school groups (lodges, clubs, churches, etc.) outside school hours and not identified as school members require no school clearance.
5. If a student is to make a personal endorsement of any commercial product, studios are asked not to identify him/her as a member of or representative of the district.
6. The program and participation in programs including rehearsals must comply with laws governing attendance and employment of minors.
