

Awards for Achievement

Outstanding Achievement Award

The Governing Board's outstanding achievement award is a high-level award distinct from local and area awards which carry their own particular publicity and prestige. This award is to recognize special and outstanding student achievement, by 9-12 grade students only, in school-sponsored activities on a state or high level.

A candidate for an outstanding achievement award should be recommended by the faculty to the principal who submits the name to the district information office and publications office for screening. That office will prepare the certificates for presentation to those who qualify.

Examples of achievement which might merit Board commendations are:

1. Placement in state tournaments or high-level regional competition.
2. Students selected to participate in the national math and science foundation summer institute.
3. Ninety-nine percentile scores on the scholastic aptitude test.
4. Finalists in the national merit scholarship tests.
5. State or national competition honors in all curricular areas (English, Science, Art, Music, Auto Mechanics, Homemaking, Athletics, Photography, Forensics, etc.).
6. Graduating seniors with a 4.0 grade average and/or valedictorian and salutatorian of each senior class.
7. Any achievement that is recognized in the area as outstanding and is recommended by the cabinet for this high award.

All faculties of the district are to be made aware of the Board's outstanding achievement award.
