

Fresno Unified Board Policy AR 6114.4 Instruction Adverse Weather/Air Quality

Air Quality/Heat Advisory

Restriction of physical activities in school during declared air pollution school and health warning episodes will be implemented in accordance with the following:

1. Real Time Air Advisory Network will provide updates on air quality. Transmission of information to schools regarding air quality will be as follows:
 - a. Notification of an alert condition from the San Joaquin Valley Air Control District and National Weather Services to the district designee
 - b. The district designee will notify the central administrative offices of the district, all departments, and all schools
 - c. Upon receipt of a notification that adverse weather has been declared, each school administrator shall be responsible for notifying all students and staff members present at their site that an episode has been declared

2. Action will be taken by the school administrator according to each level of the Real Time Air Advisory Network

Fog

In the event that fog conditions constitute a safety hazard in the operation of district and contract buses, bus schedules shall be modified accordingly.

Foggy day bus schedules will be broadcast on Valley Public Network (PBS) and radio KMJ 580 AM/105.9 FM.

The decision to delay transportation will be made by 5:30 AM. School schedules will remain the same. A district wide phone message will be sent out to all Fresno Unified families directing them to check local media sources on foggy mornings for bus delay information. In the event of a delay, site leaders are notified via school messenger and/or email. That notification will immediately go out following the decision.

First student transportation routes will be affected by the same district bus delay factors.
