

High School Graduation Requirements/Standards Of Proficiency

Each student will demonstrate the ability to meet the district minimum standards of competency in the basic skills. Competency in basic skills will be demonstrated by attaining an eighth grade proficiency level in (a) writing as determined by achieving a passing score on a writing sample and (b) mathematics, language, and reading skills as determined by achieving at least an 8.0 Grade Equivalent (GE) score on approved norm-referenced tests developed for administration at Grade 8 or higher grade levels. Approved norm-referenced tests are those used by the district or used in the State Assessment Program. Students will have the opportunity to be assessed at least twice a year, but not more than four times a year. Proficiency levels on the competency test shall be determined by the Governing Board. Those students not meeting the district minimum standards shall be provided remedial instruction in accordance with the law.
